

COLLECTION DAY

Your weekly scheduled pick-up day is:

WEDNESDAY

City Ordinance requires your cart at the curb no earlier than 8 PM Tuesday and returned no later than 8 PM Wednesday.

HOLIDAY SCHEDULE

Collection services during holiday weeks will stay on schedule up to the holiday.

Those falling on or after the holiday will be one day late. If the holiday falls on Saturday or Sunday, there will be no delay in your collection. We observe the following holidays:

- ◆ New Years Day
- ◆ Memorial Day
- ◆ Fourth of July
- ◆ Labor Day
- ◆ Thanksgiving
- ◆ Christmas

Your cart is designed to last for years with minimal care. Please do not put hot ashes or embers in your container. Any household liquid cleaner is safe to use when you wash out your cart.

Republic Waste Services will not pick up more trash than can fit in each bin. Any extra waste must be put into Republic garbage bags available at City Hall.

RESIDENTIAL COLLECTION


Items we do not pick up include:

*Yardwaste pick-up is available. Please call City Hall at 349-3785 for details.







Green Recycle Bin








Office Paper, Junk Mail,

Staples do not have to be removed




Cardboard boxes

Cut into 2' X 2' square




Brown paper bags

Yellow Recycle Bin




Clear, green & brown jars

Pie Tins, Lids from Jars


Rinse & Clean thoroughly.

Rinse well. Labels are OK.
Do not include bottle caps,
Container opening must be smaller than base.



Pop, Water & Flavored beverage bottles
(clear & green)

Narrow neck containers only; 6-pack rings
Margarine tubs, yogurt & dessert cups

1st & 3rd WEDNESDAY

of each month

Scrap metal

Window glass

Wire hangers

Batteries

Paper clips/metal fasteners

Pizza boxes

Facial tissue

Waxed or laminated paper

Food wrappers

Televisions

Ceramics, plates, etc.
