When setting a HUD mobile home in a park, a permit must include the application fee, service, feeder, and a final inspection. These shall be done by a licensed electrical contractor. When setting a HUD mobile home or a pre-manufactured home on private property, a permit must include the application fee, service, feeder, and a final inspection.

## Supplement to Electrical Permit Application

### ELECTRICAL PERMIT APPLICATION

Plans must be submitted with an application for plan examination and the appropriate deposit before a permit can be issued, except as listed below.

Plans are not required for the following:

1. When the electrical system rating does not exceed 400 amps and the building is not over 3,500 square feet in area.
2. Work completed by a governmental subdivision or state agency costing less than \$15,000.00

\*\*If work is being performed as described above, check "No" in the "Plan Review" section.

Plans are required for all other building types and shall be prepared by or under the direct supervisor of an architect or engineer licensed pursuant to 1980 PA 299 and shall bear that architect's or engineer's seal and signature.

### Instructions for Completing Application

General: Electrical work shall not be started until the application for permit has been filed with KABA. All installations shall be in conformance with the Michigan Electrical Code. **No work shall be concealed until it has been inspected.** **When ready for inspection, call KABA providing as much advance notice as possible.** KABA will need the job location and permit number.

**Expiration of Permit:** A permit remains valid as long as work is progressing and inspections are requested and conducted. A permit shall become invalid if the authorized work is not commenced within 180 days after issuance of the permit or if the authorized work is suspended or abandoned for a period of 180 after the time of commencing the work. **A PERMIT WILL BE CLOSED WHEN NO INSPECTIONS ARE REQUESTED AND CONDUCTED WITHIN 180 DAYS OF THE DATE OF ISSUANCE OR THE DATE OF A PREVIOUS INSPECTION. CLOSED PERMITS CANNOT BE REFUNDED.**
